I am writing to express my support for the brave, principled young men and women of Students Organizing for Labor and Economic Equality who are now sitting in at the Dean's office to demand that the University of Michigan join the Workers Rights Consortium (WRC).

As President of UNITE—the largest union representing apparel and textile workers in the United States—I have had experience dealing with the problems of sweatshops where workers are subjected to poverty wages and outrageous conditions.
