

The first American teach-in ^{attended by} occurred at the University of Michigan on March 24. ~~About~~ It was attended by about 3000 persons of Michigan on March 24. The format consisted of the following. ~~All~~ Three major speeches, all anti-administration, ~~was~~ ^{were} followed by a question period lasting about an hour ~~thirty~~ and a half. The schedule was disrupted by two bomb threats (the police cleared the halls once). At midnight, or thereabouts, a protest rally was held ~~in~~ ^{outside} ~~front of our library~~. After that, at about 1 AM., seminars, thirteen of them dealing with various aspects of the Vietnam ~~&~~ crisis, ~~took place~~ ~~was~~ assembled.
