Dear Martha -

Here is a letter that Representative Lou Cramton of Midland put in the Midland paper and sent to every member of the legislature. It was in response to a request I made to the Public Service Commission to consider the new evidence that has been developed on the safety, reliability and economics of nuclear plants since the Midland plants were announced. As you may recall, I sent you a copy recently.

This was a slanderous action on the part of Lou Cramton, since I was acting entirely within my rights as a citizen. He admitted he had read nothing of what I have been sending him.

A delegation from Midland was sent to the Public Service Commission asking them to deny a hearing, and they did so.

Please ask your legislators to arrange to give me at least an hour before the legislature to answer these false charges and to answer their questions. This news and developing information must be brought before a public body of some kind. This may be a way we can teach the legislature.
